



Rules

Format:

The format of the tournament is a 2-man "Ft. Lauderdale" scramble. Each person hits his (or her) tee shot and then the team chooses the best ball that they want to play. Each player then hits their next shot from that spot and again picks the best one to play. This continues until you have holed out.

Pairing and Competition:

Players competing for the trophy and awards will be drawn out of a "hat" for pairing with a partner. No consideration for player skill level will be made. Players are welcome to request a partner or foursome but in such case they will not be eligible for winning the competition.

Tees:

Men will play from the WHITE TEES

Ladies may play from the RED TEES

Rolling up:

You can roll the ball up to 12" in the fairway or rough, just as long as you do not enhance the "lie" of the ball. You cannot move it 12" inches so that you are out of a sand-trap or a hazard. You also cannot move it onto the putting surface. Also, if you are blocked by a tree, you cannot improve your lie to remove the tree as an obstacle. If you are playing from a sand-trap, each person should have similar lies. You can rake the trap before each shot.

Threesomes:

In the event of a threesome, each player in the group will play all shots, including putts. However, for this extra person advantage, the threesome will spot the field three strokes and start at 3-over par on the first tee.

Turn in your scorecard to the Golf Staff when you finish. In the event of a tie, a scorecard playoff will be held, starting at #18 and going backwards.

Closes to the Pin and Longest Drive:

We may have one or two holes each for closest to the pin and longest drive competition. All players are eligible for these competitions.

To help speed up play, PLEASE PLAY READY GOLF !!

Any competitor, who during the course of an event misbehaves by, for example, swearing, throwing clubs, or vandalizing the golf course or club house, or acts in any manner which might bring the game into disrepute, may be asked to leave the event and may be barred from entering or taking part in any event for such period as the committee may decide.
